Job Title:	Community Cricket Coach
Hours:	Flexible - minimum 20 hours per week

This position presents an exciting opportunity for the successful candidate to become part of an organisation, which is committed to growing participation and interest in cricket on the Isle of Man. This role requires organisational skills, coaching skills, leadership, enthusiasm, communication skills and the ability to relate to and enthuse all stakeholders within the game of cricket.

JOB PURPOSE

The Community Cricket Coach role is a flexible role, working alongside the Cricket Development Officer (CDO) and High-Performance Coach. The role focuses on delivering the key elements of the Isle of Man Cricket Development Plan. This will be a 'hands on' post working in schools primarily, but also delivering IOMCA community programmes in and out of school term time and coaching junior age group squads, both male and female.

The post holder must always ensure that the IOM Safeguarding Policy Guidelines are observed and upheld by all stakeholders in IOM cricket.

MAIN DUTIES

1. To ensure that cricket remains a visible option in Isle of Man schools by continuing to deliver 'Cric Kids' to all schools (Reception to Year 2) across the Isle of Man.
2. Delivering Formal 'Kwik' cricket in all schools (Year 3 to Year 6) across the Isle of Man.
3. Delivering Soft ball cricket in female secondary school Physical Education lessons across the Isle of Man.
4. Developing IOMCA community initiatives. Developing the 'face' of cricket in the community.

5. Delivering the IOMCA community programmes and seek ways to expand community programmes.
6. Support MSR (Manx Sport and Recreation) initiatives including Manx Youth Games and Community Games.
7. Assist and support clubs within junior cricket club competitions.
8. Develop and promote female junior and senior soft ball and hardball festivals and leagues.
9. Assist in the delivery of the Isle of Man representative programme.
10. Assist the CDO with junior male and female squad training sessions.
11. Assist CDO and High-Performance Coach and team coaches at IOM squad matches and festivals.

OTHER DUTIES

Communication

1. Develop strong relationships with volunteers, coaches, school staff and club officials
Maintain consistent communication between schools and other bodies involved in the governance and delivery of junior cricket for boys and girls.
2. Update the IOMCA social media accounts including Website and Facebook.
3. Communicate positively with all stakeholders, players, coaches, schools, clubs, teachers and parents.
4. Able to provide the vision, energy and passion for junior cricket so that others follow willingly and in a fully committed way.
