

## Senior committee meeting notes Wed 16<sup>th</sup> October 2024

Apologies: Union Mills

**League review 2024** - all clubs please come with feedback from club members.

**Cronkbourne:** Weekend buy in for T20, Nothing to say 40 over or Midweek T20, T10 - some enjoyed, some lower team captains.... What's the point?

**PSJ:** 40 over not enjoyable as lots of teams scored the same or even less than in a T20, it just took twice as long. T10 was enjoyable and the lads would like to play more. Lower leagues would benefit from more T20 as some people don't get a go.

**Crosby:** Higher division teams would like more T10, otherwise similar to others, the mix of format worked well

**Finch Hill:** Overall format worked well. T10 enjoyed – would like a multi team ECN format finals day. Not heard from the other teams, but T10 not a suitable for juniors.

**Valkyres:** Similar to others T20/T40/T10 divisions well received. T20 Weekend worked well. T10 took time to adjust to but the boys like it now. Can we have a superover?

**Ramsey:** T20 Saturday worked well. 40 overs, how about Red ball? T10 not well received especially by 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rds</sup>. Disappointed not to play Valkyres during the season. Some teams had to travel too far for T10 on numerous occasions.

**Castletown:** T20 start at weekend was good. 30/35 was good – competitive level. Midweek – T20 competitive, may struggle if firsts are in Premier League. Competitive V Ramsey. Some clubs teams strength changed quite a bit. You didn't know who would turn up to play against you (player consistency in opposition teams was an issue) T10 not really suitable lower divisions.

**Scoring:** Very few reported issues. Clubs need to audit their equipment as Play-cricket has been updated and may not work on current ipads etc. IOMCA confirmed they can't replace the clubs current devices and clubs need to ensure they have compatible devices for next season.

**Umpires:** Issues raised with clubs not using Umpires that have completed the ICC course. Valkyres requested official umpires. The cost is prohibitive. Greig confirmed that there are 64 ICC registered umpires within clubs on the island. It is a clubs responsibility to ensure their players are qualified to stand. As of next season all players

that officiate must have completed the ICC course. Captains are responsible for ensuring the umpires are respected and their decision is final.

**Facilities:** Finch Hill are hoping to arrange a formal agreement with Union Mills for next season.

**IOMCA update.** See attached documents. IOMCA have put in place a new league structure to grow cricket. This is to ensure the growth of cricket and the ability to enable more facility usage at the weekend.

This includes the following changes:

- More T10 and T20 cricket
- Change to numbers of teams in each league
- All midweek cricket on a Wednesday
- Finals day
- Promotion relegation for teams finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> possible

2. Player members don't need to be officially registered on Play-cricket. Temporary members count as unique players.
